

**MINUTES OF THE CANVASSING BOARD MEETING
OF THE ZIMMERMANCITY COUNCIL
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2020**

CALL TO ORDER

The Zimmerman City Council met as the Canvassing Board on Thursday, November 12, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall by Mayor Stay.

ROLL CALL

Present: Mayor Stay, Council Members Bondhus, Frederick, and Whiting. Member Shepard was excused absent. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann.

AGENDA APPROVAL

The agenda was approved by unanimous consensus as presented.

CANVASSING BOARD

Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann provided a review of 2020 Election activity. The City of Zimmerman held a Municipal Election in conjunction with the Federal and State General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. When the polls opened, there were 3,506 registered voters residing within the two City precincts with an additional 350 voters registered throughout the day. Sherburne County processed 837 absentee ballots on behalf of the City. Voter turnout was calculated at 83.4%. The results of the Municipal Election were presented as follows:
