

**MINUTES OF THE CANVASSING BOARD MEETING
OF THE ZIMMERMANCITY COUNCIL
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER The Zimmerman City Council met as the Canvassing Board on Tuesday, November 13, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall by Mayor Earenfight.

ROLL CALL Present: Mayor Earenfight, Council Members Brisbin, Mathison, Shepard and Whiting. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann.

AGENDA APPROVAL **The agenda was approved by unanimous consensus as presented.**

CANVASSING BOARD

Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann provided a review of 2018 Election activity. The City of Zimmerman held a Municipal Election in conjunction with the Federal and State General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. When the polls opened, there were 3,151 registered voters residing within the two City precincts with an additional 188 voters registered throughout the day. Sherburne County processed 186 absentee ballots on behalf of the City. Voter turnout was calculated at 65.32%. The results of the Municipal Election were presented as follows:
