

**MINUTES OF THE CANVASSING BOARD MEETING
OF THE ZIMMERMANCITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2022**

CALL TO ORDER

The Zimmerman City Council met as the Canvassing Board on Monday, November 14, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. at City Hall by Mayor Stay.

ROLL CALL

Present: Mayor Stay, Council Members Bondhus, Dahl, Earenfight, and Whiting. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann.

AGENDA APPROVAL

The agenda was approved by unanimous consensus as presented.

CANVASSING BOARD

Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann provided a review of 2022 Election activity. The City of Zimmerman held a Municipal Election in conjunction with the Federal and State General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. When polls opened at 7:00 a.m., there were 3,815 registered voters residing within the two City precincts, and an additional 107 voters registered throughout the day. A total of 899 ballots were cast in-person in Precinct 1, and 1,115 ballots cast in-person in Precinct 2. Sherburne County processed 195 absentee ballots on behalf of the City. Voter turnout was calculated at 57.9%.

Tillmann reported that because of the small difference in votes cast between the 2nd and 3rd place candidates, a recount has been requested, which will be held later in November 2022. Tillmann is coordinating recount activities with the Sherburne County Auditor/Treasurer's Office.
