

**MINUTES OF THE WORKSHOP
OF THE ZIMMERMAN CITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2023**

CALL TO ORDER

The Zimmerman City Council met in a workshop session at the Zimmerman City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m. at City Hall by Acting Mayor Whiting.

ROLL CALL

Present: Council Members Dahl, Earenfight, Farber and Acting Mayor Whiting. Mayor Stay was excused absent. Also present was Administrator Piasecki, Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann, Public Works Director Koehler and Streets, Parks, and Utility Supervisor Dallager.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION

Council discussed several future goals and objectives centering on the following:

- Lake Fremont – the potential creation of Lake Improvement District. Staff will seek input from the Lake Association regarding interest or a potential meeting to discuss.
- City Hall – Council discussed future staffing and building needs to accommodate future growth of the City.
- City Codes and Ordinances – Currently the City Attorney is reviewing sections related to Business Licensing. Discussion centered on updating and codifying all City Codes and Ordinances to bring current.
- Comprehensive Plan Update – The City’s comprehensive plan was due to be updated around the time of the 2008 recession. Due to the slowdown in growth and construction activity, it was decided that the plan was still valid as written, however, due to recent population increases and building activity, it is possibly time to start an update to the plan. Administrator Piasecki will provide copies of the Comprehensive Plan to Council for review and discussion at future workshop sessions.

Acting Mayor Whiting adjourned the workshop at 7:55 p.m.
