

**MINUTES OF THE WORKSHOP  
OF THE ZIMMERMAN CITY COUNCIL  
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2023**

**CALL TO ORDER**

The Zimmerman City Council met in a workshop session at the Zimmerman City Hall on Tuesday, December 19, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Mayor Stay.

**ROLL CALL**

Present: Mayor Stay, Council Members Dahl, Earenfight, Farber, and Whiting. Also present was Administrator Piasecki and Clerk/Treasurer Tillmann.

**COUNCIL DISCUSSION**

Council discussed several future goals and objectives centering on the following:

- ISD 728 – Recently, the ISD 728 School Board censured 2 members that represent the Zimmerman area. More information will be provided to Council if it becomes available.
- City of Princeton request regarding Baldwin Township – Mayor Stay was recently contacted by the Mayor of Princeton, who asked if the City was going to respond either for or against the potential incorporation of Baldwin Township. Council agreed by unanimous consensus that Baldwin Township’s incorporation would have little impact on the City of Zimmerman and did not warrant a response at this time.
- Zimmerman/Livonia Fire District – Fire Board representatives provided an update on recent District activities, including interviews for the vacant Event Center Coordinator position and approval of the 2024 Fire District Budget. Council requested staff compile information on the possible creation of a taxing district for the Fire District.
- Possible Annexation or Merger with Livonia Township – Council reviewed discussions to date regarding a potential merger or annexation of a portion of Livonia Township and future growth of the City. Staff will contact the City Attorney to establish a potential future workshop date.

**Mayor Stay adjourned the workshop at 8:03 p.m.**
